### “THE ROAD TO EMMAUS: A FEMININE PERSPECTIVE”

**Tuesday Mornings: May 2 to May 23, 2017**

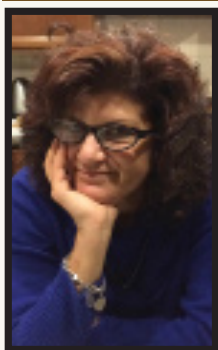
This four-part series will look into Luke’s Gospel story of the Road to Emmaus, yet from a woman’s point of view. We know that the followers of Jesus walked that road to return home after the death of Jesus; however, what we do not know is if one of those walking was a woman and how the story would be different if indeed a woman walked with and perhaps recognized Jesus.

**Here is the schedule of dates and themes - (9:30 am to 2:00pm):**

- **May 2** - The Scriptural Story
  - Where is Emmaus (then and now)
  - Who walked...
  - What if one was a woman?
- **May 9** - Anguish, despair, and disappointment
  - Where am I in all this?
  - Jesus the Prophet and redeemer
  - Jesus’ relationship with women
  - My relationship with Jesus
- **May 16** - Women in Jesus’ time: what they could do, and what they couldn’t do
  - Jesus meets them where they are at, do I?
  - My personal walk with Jesus
  - Encountering and Recognizing
- **May 23** - The woman at the tomb
  - Resurrection, Hope, Easter Season... NOW
  - What does the Resurrected Jesus say to you?
  - The constant presence of God-we are NEVER alone
  - My relationship with Jesus

Each session will include times for information, historical facts, scriptural material, reflection, meditation, silence, and group discussion.
